Parents or guardians must have taught in the Columbus City Schools for four years prior to the application date and must be continuous CEA or CEA-R members. Payment to approved applicants will be sent directly to the college or university on record.

CEA Members Scholarship Foundation Guidelines 2021–2022

Application Filing Deadline: October 15, 2021

The purpose of the CEA Member Scholarship Foundation is to provide monetary assistance to Columbus teachers who are members of CEA, and whose dependent children are pursuing a college or university degree.

Ten dollars (\$10) of each member's yearly dues will be invested in the fund through payroll deduction. The interest earned from the previous year's investments plus any additional amount necessary will be given to each eligible candidate and paid directly to the college or university. Currently, the scholarship is valued at **\$1,500**.

For their dependent(s) to be eligible, a teacher must have:

1. Taught in Columbus City Schools and maintained continuous CEA membership for four (4) years prior to applying for the scholarship unless the applicant taught for four (4) years prior to:
 - a. Going on an approved leave of absence
 - b. Going on an approved disability retirement
 - c. Retiring and maintaining membership in CEA-R

Non-members are not eligible for this scholarship.

Note: Dependent children of deceased members who have met all requirements will be eligible for benefits.

The following documents are required to apply for the CEA Member Scholarship Fund 2021–2022:

1. Thoroughly completed Application Form
2. An official transcript is required to verify satisfactory completion of the previous year at an accredited college or university and achievement of a 2.0 GPA. Note that this document must be university generated. The official transcript will not be accepted if it is **faxed, copied, or emailed** from the applicant. Acceptable methods of submission are either receiving the transcript **in a sealed envelope from the college or university** or one that is **electronically generated directly from the college or university clearing house, sent directly to wilkesk@ceaohio.org.**
3. An official validation form (also known as verification form) is required to verify enrollment and senior status at an accredited college or university. This form is included with the scholarship application. The registrar may also choose to use their own verification form. This document must be completed and signed by the college or university registrar.

The complete application form, as well as all other required materials must be received at the CEA office no later than **4:30 pm on October 15, 2021**. Send completed applications to:
